Digital Summer Art Camp, 2020

Greater Reston Arts Center (GRACE) realizes that the availability of summer camp is needed now more than ever. In response we are pleased to offer GRACE Digital Summer Art Camp for the 2020 summer season.

GRACE Digital Summer Art Camp will mirror much of what is offered in our in-person program:

- Weekly camps will run for six weeks between June 29-August 7, 2020.
- The program's camp themes will remain the same. They will continue to focus on many aspects of art-making while encouraging children to expand their artistic vocabulary and creativity through hands-on art activities.
- Activities will be taught and led by a professional art educator.

New to the program this year:

- All activities will be visually demonstrated in short, pre-recorded videos of 15 minutes or less and will be accompanied with easy-to-follow written instructions. All activity instructions and videos will be made accessible online through a private link sent to parents via email.
- Each camper will receive a "camp-in-a-box" kit that will include most of the special materials required for the activities. A list of basic items for families to have at home will be available prior to the start of camp.
- The camp kits will be prepared with supplies and materials that GRACE staff members have ordered online. Both the shipment boxes from the online purchases and camp kits will be handled by a PPE-wearing GRACE staff member (masks, gloves, etc.). Camp kits will be available for contact-less, no-touch pickup each Saturday between 12pm – 2pm at GRACE. Masks will be required as parents approach the building for pickup.
- Designed with the busy parent and caretaker in mind, camp kits come with a suggested daily schedule to help keep campers engaged throughout the day. For those who want more fluidity in the schedule, we will continue to offer the pre-recorded lesson videos for 30 days after camp has begun, so that campers can go back to activities they might have missed (or repeat the ones they really loved!).

Our goal is to provide a meaningful, virtual, and safe summer camp experience for our staff and for your family. We require all families to read, understand, and sign the following Liability Waiver and Release Form based on acknowledgement of both the aforementioned information and terms below.

Liability Waiver and Release Form

The Greater Reston Arts Center (together with its members, directors, officers, employees, contractors, and/or agents, "GRACE") is a non-profit institution. Digital Summer Camp is a part of its offerings to enrich community life through excellence and involvement in the visual arts. Consequently, you acknowledge, represent, and warrant that:

1. Certain risks exist in the Digital Summer Camp. These include, but are not limited to, the hazards of handling the materials and supplies provided, handling electronics, and risks associated with access to the Internet (viruses/malware). In consideration of this acknowledgement, you are aware of and accept the risks associated with your child's participation in this program.
2. GRACE reserves the right to cancel individual camp sessions due to, but not limited by, unforeseen circumstances. If GRACE cancels any individual camp, families will receive a full refund. Payment for camp is to be made online only by credit/debit card and is due one week prior to the start of the individual camp session. All payments are final.
3. GRACE reserves the right to not serve, deliver, or work with any individuals who do not comply with the process and terms listed in these documents.

YOU AND/OR YOUR CHILD/DEPENDENT HEREBY RELEASE, RELIEVE, INDEMNIFY, REIMBURSE, DEFEND, AND HOLD HARMLESS GRACE FROM AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, ACTIONS, CAUSES OF ACTION, SUITS, LIABILITIES, COSTS, LOSSES, DEMANDS, JUDGMENTS, OR DAMAGES OF ANY KIND (INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION DIRECT, INDIRECT, ACTUAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, PUNITIVE, OR SPECIAL, AND ATTORNEY'S FEES INCURRED IN DEFENDING OR RESPONDING TO SAME) ARISING OUT OF YOUR CHILD'S/DEPENDENT'S PARTICIPATION IN SUMMER CAMP.
